Mission

What is the Brussels Drohme Golf Club :

For young people: we want to make sure that children:

> Have fun, progress and meet each other in a safe environment.

The Brussels Drohme Golf Club is mainly focused:

On training the 'recreational player', but the BDGC also has sufficient knowledge and skills to attract and guide the 'competitive player'.

A quality and accessible junior program:

In this program, **different formulas** are submitted to the Juniors with which, we believe, all will feel comfortable and will progress at their own pace.

Our aim is that the children train together and attend the various competitions organised by Golf Vlaanderen or AFGOLF.



Allow children to play:

In a safe environment, where great emphasis is given to sportsmanship, respect for the rules and fair play, but also the respect for nature. These issues are also included in the program and will also be rewarded annually.

As a golf club:

Juniors are the future : if we give them the relevant support from the very beginning, we will get good results and above all, long time Golf players.



Long term objectives (2027)

- 3 interclub Teams
- Regular participation in VVG, AFG, and federal competitions
- «Golf in schools » and « Play 4 Peace » programs to make the sport more accessible and known
- A wide range of activities for juniors with or without golf. Holiday courses, masterclasses, group and private lessons, meetings, seminars, ...
- Maintain the rabbit and birdie label and if possible, aim for the eagle label.



Short term objectives (2025)

- Approximately 150 juniors are participating in the program. A juniors that starts in 2023 must obtain his/her hcp 36 in 2 years.
- Develop competitive activities where juniors can meet and play golf together.
- A clear teaching and training agenda for each level (from 54 to hcp 0), with clear objectives indicated.

Evolution of the junior

54 to 45

- Throughout Academy trainings, the juniors will perfect numerous competences in order to learn the game.
- Those competences will be tested during the year. Once successfully passed, the junior will receive a PIN corresponding to the skill. Once he/she will have obtained all the PINS, they will be able to go on the course with an initiator to get the first handicap.
- > The different exercises are inspired by the VVG, the AFGolf and the PGA of Europe.
- > The tests will be conducted during the trainings with the initiators.
- > Test on the course: between 3 and 4 over the year.
